1 School of Mines

Although a vibrant mining and resource cluster already exists at Laurentian, including internationally-recognized geology, engineering, environmental and business programs and research centres, the university has aspirations of further enhancing its ability to provide unparalleled mining-related education. To achieve this goal, a multidisciplinary, internationally linked School of Mines has been established that will build on Laurentian's existing and potential strengths, as well as the strategic advantages that come from being situated in the richest mining district in North America.

The School of Mines will become the national and international centre of excellence in mining education and research, and will develop the scientific, technical, socio-economic, and management skills of mining-related exploration, engineering, health, and environmental professionals around the world.

Investment highlights:

Quadra FNX Mining Company Ltd. (now KGHM) pledged \$1 million in support of the School of Mines in 2010.

2 Voyageur Athletics

In 2011, Dario and Julie Zulich invested \$250,000 in Laurentian Voyageur Athletics. Mr. Zulich, president and CEO of TESC Contracting Company and co-chair of the Sudbury Families initiative, spent many hours during his childhood frequenting the Laurentian gymnasium.

3 Student Support

Sharon Clarke (Laurentian BA Hons 1991) wanted to leave a lasting legacy. "We live in Sudbury, we have a good life here, and we wanted to give something back," says Clarke. 1 École des mines

Même s'il existe déjà un groupe dynamique sur les mines et les ressources à la Laurentienne, par exemple, les programmes et centres de géologie, de génie, environnementaux et d'affaires, l'Université aspire à augmenter sa capacité d'offrir un enseignement sans pareil dans le domaine minier. À cette fin, elle a établi l'École des mines, une unité multidisciplinaire qui a des liens internationaux et qui misera sur les points forts actuels et potentiels de la Laurentienne ainsi que sur les atouts stratégiques découlant de son emplacement dans le plus riche district minier d'Amérique du Nord.

L'École des mines deviendra le centre national et international d'excellence en formation et recherche en la matière, et dotera les professionnels de l'exploration minière, du génie, de la santé et de l'environnement du monde entier de compétences scientifiques, techniques, socioéconomiques et en gestion.

Investissement marquant :

Quadra FNX Mining Company Ltd. (maintenant KGHM) a promis un million de dollars pour l'École des mines en 2010.

2 Sports interuniversitaires des Voyageurs

En 2011, Dario et Julie Zulich ont investi 250 000 \$ dans les Voyageurs de la Laurentienne. M. Zulich, PDG de TESC Contracting Company et coprésident de l'initiative Familles de Sudbury, a passé de nombreuses heures dans le gymnase de la Laurentienne pendant son enfance.

3 Appui à la population étudiante

Sharon Clarke (B.A. spécialisé 1999) voulait, dit-elle, laisser un héritage durable. « Nous vivons à Sudbury, dit-elle, y menons une bonne vie et voulons redonner quelque chose à la communauté. » Elle et son mari, Dave Holla, ont fondé la Bourse Clarke-Holla au profit des étudiants actifs dans les sports. Ils ont laissé à l'Université un legs testamentaire soulignant que la « Laurentienne a tant de bonnes choses à offrir. » Ce legs ou don planifié profitera à des générations à venir.
