Electives	33 cr.	To a maximum of 78 credits in Music and a minimum of 42 credits in non-Music courses.
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It is important to take note that:

- Students must take a minimum of **60 music credits** and a minimum of **42 credits of non-music courses**. The remaining **18 credits** may be either music or non-music courses.
- Only 42 credits of first-year courses may count towards the degree.
- Only 78 credits of music courses may count towards the degree.
- Six credits of each of science and social science must be completed before graduation.

- MUSC 1455 & 2455 may be taken in lieu of 1406 & 2406 depending on the scheduling of required courses in the second Major.
